BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

A. SR-57/60 Confluence Improvements Project

Ongoing weekend overnight closures continue along westbound SR-60 near Grand Avenue as part of the SR-57/60 Confluence Chokepoint Relief Project to support bridge construction activities. Westbound SR-60 between Lemon Avenue and Diamond Bar Boulevard is periodically closed on weekends from midnight to 6:00 a.m. Several connector ramps and on-/off-ramps within the project area are also temporarily closed during these operations. Detour routes and advance warning signage remain in place throughout the affected area. City staff continues to coordinate with the contractor, project inspectors, and the City's Public Information team to keep the public informed about upcoming closures and construction activities. B. Diamond Bar Blvd Complete Streets Project

Construction continues to progress along Diamond Bar Boulevard, on the west side, as part of the Complete Streets Project. Current work includes grading and compaction activities for future sidewalk and bike lane improvements north of Golden Springs Drive, continued construction of the new bio-retention wall for stormwater treatment and green street enhancements, and ongoing traffic signal and lighting upgrades near Golden Springs Drive and Palomino Drive. Crews are also continuing irrigation installation and landscaping preparation activities throughout the corridor. Additional improvements remain underway near Gentle Springs Lane, including curb drain repairs and ADA accessibility upgrades to enhance pedestrian accessibility and overall corridor functionality. The project remains on schedule to be completed in February 2027, and city staff continue to coordinate closely with the construction manager, inspectors, contractor, and local business owners/residents to address construction-related issues and maintain communication throughout all phases of the project.
